

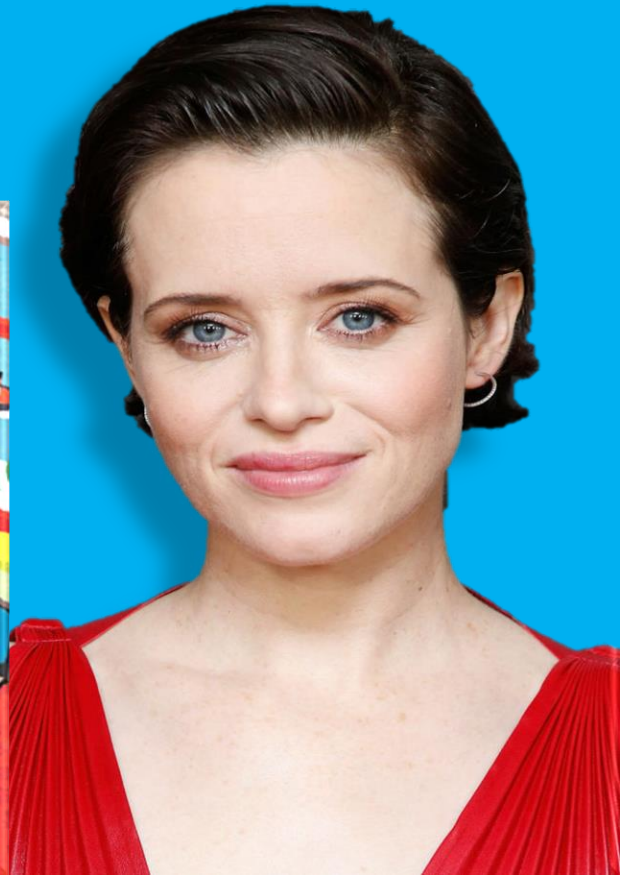

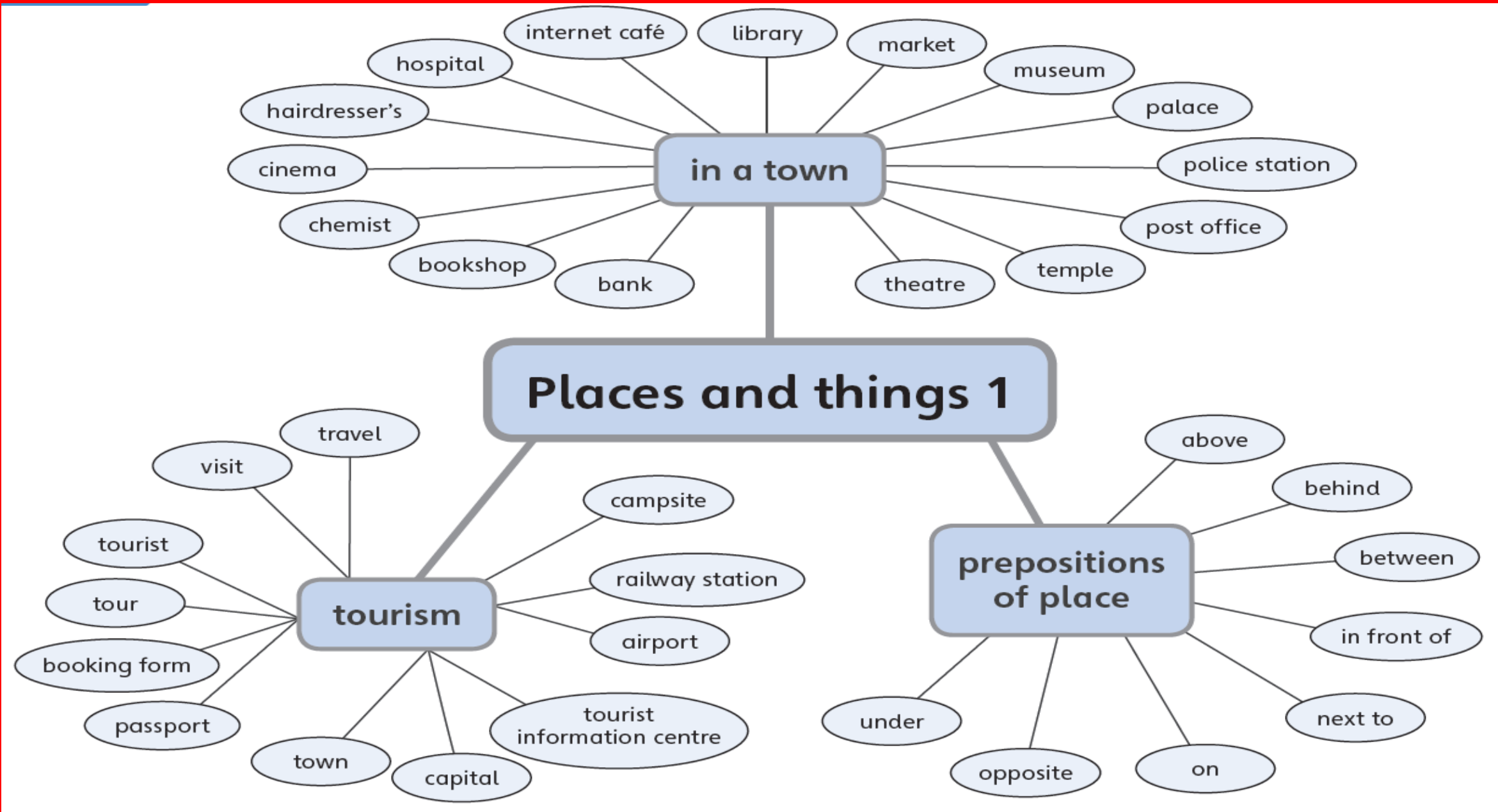

When we know sb or sth we are talking about: **use *the***

When we talk about sth that there is only one thing.

use a/an, the or no article in certain situations - phrases.

He's **an** engineer and she's **a** bank manager. Their parents are **teachers**.

5. use a/an to talk about: → **people's jobs in singular, NOT in plural.**

6. use no article with: → **people's names, street names, cities and most countries**
